- **March 30, 2022** - Deadline to register in person or by mail
- **April 9, 2022** - Deadline to register online

- **April 26, 2022** - Deadline to request an absentee ballot from Registrar of Voters
- **April 29, 2022** - Deadline for Registrar to receive absentee ballot

- Arterbury Building in New Sarpy, 14564 River Road (Eastbank)

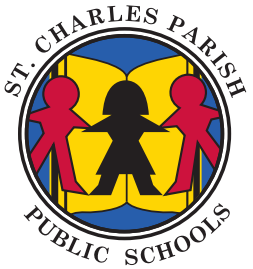

PURPOSE

ON SATURDAY, APRIL 30,

Voter approval for a \$35 million bond issue with no increase in the current tax rate will help accomplish this goal.

PASSAGE OF BOND ISSUE WILL HELP IMPROVE

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Destrehan High School

- Renovation of existing career and technical education area to modernize and improve functionality
- Addition of covered outdoor workspace adjacent to career and technical education area



Hahnville High School

- Renovation of existing career and technical education area to modernize and improve functionality
- Construction of new classroom building addition for career and technical education area



Satellite Center

- Renovation of applied science wing to modernize and improve functionality
- Construction of new classroom building addition

PASSAGE OF BOND ISSUE WILL ALLOW FOR

SCHOOL/CENTER RENOVATIONS & ADDITIONS

All Middle Schools

- Renovation and conversion of computer labs to STEAM labs at Albert Cammon Middle, Harry Hurst Middle, J.B. Martin Middle and R.K. Smith Middle Schools

Destrehan and Hahnville High Schools

- Renovation and conversion of libraries to flexible, digital media spaces
- Renovation of science labs at Destrehan High School

East Bank Head Start Center

- Construction of new building addition to include classrooms and office space
- Reconfiguration to allow for parking, a bus circle and a drop-off canopy
- Renovation of building J including new paint, light fixtures, flooring, ceiling work, technology and furnishings



Harry Hurst and J.B. Martin Middle Schools

- Addition of elevator to building A at J.B. Martin Middle School
- Replacement of existing building B elevator at Harry Hurst Middle School

Luling Elementary School

- Renovations of buildings B, C and D including new paint, light fixtures, flooring, ceiling work, technology, furnishings and restrooms

R.K. Smith Middle School

- Expansion of main building to construct additional classrooms including new paint, light fixtures, flooring, ceiling work, technology and furnishings

- Upgrade technology network infrastructure
- Equip classrooms with up-to-date, interactive large screen devices
- Install additional security cameras and upgrade existing cameras
