Student records and progress are maintained and updated through PowerSchool. PowerSchool is an Internet-based student information system. Through Parent Portal, one of the components of PowerSchool, administrators, teachers, and parents have access to appropriate student information including assignments, report card grades, teacher comments, and attendance history, enabling all stakeholders to support teaching and learning.
