Talented Theatre Class Requirements

- Students are expected to actively participate in class and complete all assignments in the classroom. **Students** <u>are not</u> <u>required to participate in the Fall Play or Spring Musical</u>, although they are invited to do so.
- SHOWCASES
 - If a student is enrolled in Talented Theatre, they will be required to participate in a Fall Showcase (Dec 8, 2023) or Spring Showcase (May 3, 2024) dependent upon his/her enrollment. Please mark your calendars.
 - o Showcases will be rehearsed in class with **no after-school rehearsals**. A one night only public performance for family/friends will happen at the end of each Semester. The goal is to fulfill their IEP requirements of getting on stage at least once per year.
- Supplies: \$25 theatre fee, highlighter, pencils, & Theatre folder/binder to keep scripts or handouts.
- Students should bring their Chromebook daily.
- Students are expected to check Google Classroom for any/all announcements and weekly assignments.
