

### Stakeholder Information Sheet

### Week of August 10-14, 2020



**ELA-** Welcome to the new year! This week, we will review Chromebook expectations, begin utilizing new online platforms, and conduct reading screeners and the LEAP 360 Diagnostic Assessment to gauge reading and writing levels. On Wednesday, we will begin our first ELA Unit: Wonderstruck. We will read through page 87 this week and focus on characters, comparing and contrasting, and summarizing. Students are encouraged to reread pages read during class for homework.

**Math-** This week in math, students will be learning all about our math classroom expectations. We will spend some time reviewing in class procedures and Chromebook procedures. We will then begin our study of place value by learning how digits in a number are related to each other. For example, the 4 in 24.6 is 10 times larger than the 4 in 32.48.

**Social Studies-** This week we will begin examining various definitions of civilization and use knowledge of current society to develop a “value-free” definition of civilization based on common characteristics, rather than looking only at what makes the society advanced based on modern-day expectations.

**Science-** Young scientists will review lab safety rules and begin Module 1 by observing pictures of the Statue of Liberty and generating questions about their observations. We will create our anchor model to show the change in the Statue of Liberty’s appearance as well as sort our questions to determine how to investigate and answer them. On next Monday, students will take their first quiz on lab safety rules.
