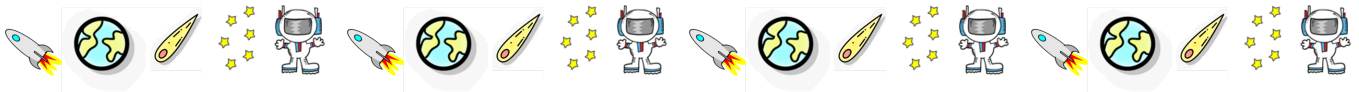

### Stakeholder Information Sheet

### Week of January 19–22, 2021




**ELA-** This week in ELA, students will begin working on the Extension Task for Unit 1. Students will review and discuss our learning of the effects Christopher Columbus had on the Natives in the Americas. Students will go through the writing process to write an essay beginning with brainstorming their ideas via a t-chart, then begin writing their rough draft. On Thursday/Friday, students will take their Section 6 quiz.

**Math-** Students will continue building on their knowledge of finding a fraction of a set. Students will study Module 4, Lessons 8-9 in which they will relate a fraction of a set to the repeated addition interpretation of fraction multiplication and will find a fraction of a measurement, and solve word problems. Please note that students will only get a reference sheet with some conversions on it for the LEAP 2025 test so most conversions need to be memorized. On Thursday/Friday, students will take the Module 4 Topics A-D Interim.

**Social Studies-** This week in Social Studies, scholars will research and analyze primary sources to prepare for their Unit 3 Early Colonization of North America EAGLE Assessment. This will be accomplished by describing **two** ways in which the colonial period in North America has influenced the economic or social development of the United States. Scholars will also complete a D.A.R.E. lesson with Office Dwayne.

**Science-** This week, student scientists will begin to investigate our first Focus Question, “Where does freshwater come from?” On Tuesday, they will analyze data on the amounts or and distribution of fresh versus salt water on Earth. On Wednesday through Friday, they will explore marine ecosystems that exist within Earth’s oceans. Quiz #2 will cover this week’s lessons and will be given on next Monday, January 25th.
