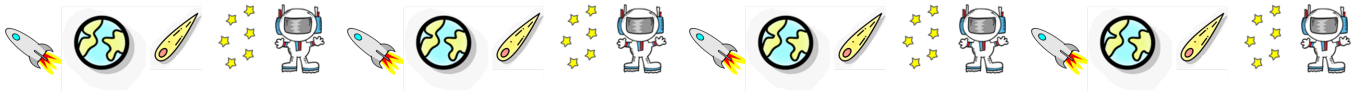

Stakeholder Information Sheet

Week of January 4-8, 2021




ELA- This week, we will continue in our Unit 3 study of the relationships between Europeans and Native Americans as the two cultures clashed during settling of the present day United States. We will continue reading *The Birchbark House*, focusing on the significance of the point of view in which the story is being told. We will also plan for and carry out a philosophical chairs debate to dispute the positive and negative consequences of European exploration and colonization in the New World.

Math- In math this week, students will conclude their study of Module 3. Students will spend Monday and Tuesday reviewing all skills learned in Module 3 to prepare for their Module 3 test that will be given on Wednesday. On Thursday, we will begin our study of Module 4 which covers Multiplication and Division of Fractions and Decimal Fractions. In Lesson 1, students will measure and compare pencil lengths to the nearest $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, and $\frac{1}{8}$ of an inch, and analyze the data through line plots.

Social Studies- This week students will sharpen their skills to state a claim, provide supportive evidence, and state their reasoning as we debate the most significant developments in the United States colonies during the 17th century.

Science- On Monday, student scientists will discuss invasive species (Module 2 Lesson 20). Then, they will spend the rest of the week discussing and implementing test-taking strategies (like CER) as they work through completing the LEAP 2020 Science LEAP Practice test.
