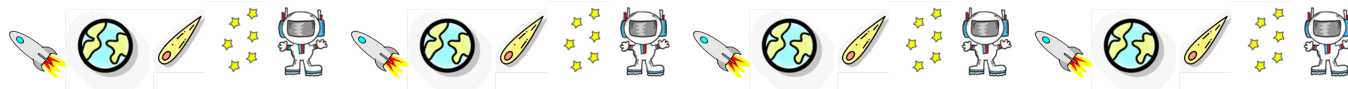

### Stakeholder Information Sheet

### Week of March 15–19 2021




**ELA-** This week, we will compare and contrast texts and a digital source to gain more information about the classification of Pluto. Students will continue to work on identifying main ideas and key details. To practice this skill, students will read portions of *13 Planets*. In addition, we will practice identifying and constructing introductory clauses in a complex sentence. At the end of the week, students will outline a paragraph through the use of a TEE frame.

**Math-** Students will continue exploring the concept of volume this week. We will learn how to use a multiplication formula to find the volume of rectangular prisms. We will also use that formula to find the height of and the area of the base of a rectangular prism when given the volume. We will then learn how to find the volume of figures that have 2 rectangular prisms. We will conclude our week by taking a LEAP practice test session.

**Social Studies-** This week we will begin preparation for LEAP2025. According to Louisiana Believes, “ The LEAP 2025 tests are just one of several indicators, in combination with report cards, teacher-made tests, and classroom work, that are used to create a complete picture of a student’s performance in school.” We will use the practice tools to ensure your students’ success.

**Science-** The student scientists will create an initial model of observations of the Sun, the Moon, and stars from Earth (Lesson 2) on Monday. We’ll discuss differences between Earth’s atmosphere and outer space (Lesson 3) on Tuesday, and how gravity pulls matter towards Earth’s center (Lesson 4) on Wednesday. On Thursday, they will take Quiz #1 on Module 4 Lessons 1-4.
