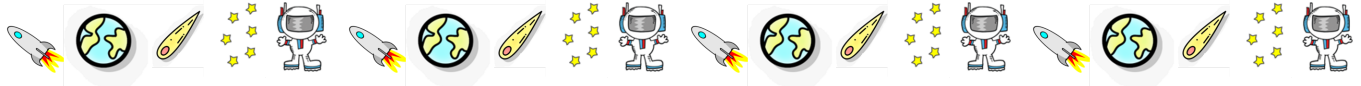

### Stakeholder Information Sheet

### Week of September 21-25, 2020



**ELA-** This week in ELA, students will participate in a philosophical chairs debate in which they must choose a character who is most similar to Ann Sullivan. Following the debate lesson, students will compose a written response explaining the reasons and evidence for why the character they chose is most similar to Ann Sullivan. Students will revise their responses to include the perfect tense. We will move on in Part Two of *Wonderstruck* and will continue to seek examples of communication within the two stories and notice how they contribute to the overall theme: Effective communication develops strong relationships.

**Math-** This week, students will continue their study of decimal numbers. We will learn how to add and subtract two decimal numbers. Students will take a quiz on this topic on Tuesday. Students will then learn how to multiply a whole number by a decimal. For example, we will find the product of  $3.41 \times 7$ . Students will also begin to learn how to divide with a decimal number. Adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing will have students using their place value knowledge to support their reasoning. We will also use models (place value disks) to help us solve these problems.

**Social Studies-** This week, students will engage in independent research about an indigenous group in the Americas (i.e., the Maya, Aztec, Inca, and various Native American cultures). They will determine the characteristics of civilizations exemplified by each group. Following the independent research, students will present their information to the class so all students build their understanding of what it means to be civilized.

**Science-** On Monday, 5th Grade scientists will review the answers to the Study Guide (sent home last Friday) covering Module 1 Lessons 1-12. On Tuesday, they will take their first Science Test of this quarter on Module 1 Lessons 1-12, then they'll investigate mixing substances on Wednesday (Lesson 13), and dissolving substances on Thursday (Lesson 14). Students will take Quiz #5 on Module 1 Lessons 13-14 on Monday, Sept. 28th.
