English Language Arts

This week we will begin to conclude our "Louisiana Purchase" unit. As we finish this unit, we will complete our culminating task as a final summative grade by answering the question: **Who benefited the most and who benefited the least from the Louisiana Purchase?** We will do this by reviewing what we have learned throughout our unit regarding the important people that have played a part in the Louisiana Purchase, analyzing the important evidence and using it in our response.

We will also continue to prepare for our upcoming LEAP Test beginning on May 6th. Please review homework over the next few weeks with your child, as it will be a direct reflection of what will be seen on the LEAP assessment. Encourage your child to eliminate answers and always go back into the text. Anything done in class can be taken for a grade.

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Flex Grouping will continue this week. Each child is placed in their flex group based on their individual needs. This week in social studies, we start **Unit 2, Chapter 1: How the United States Government Works**. They will learn about the three branches of government and the framework of the United States government.

Math

This week in math, we will continue Module 6: Geometry, Measurement, and Data. We will complete lessons 13-17, focusing on problem-solving with perimeter. Students will take a Module 6 Topic A (lessons 1-5) quiz on **Tuesday**. **Students should complete the page numbers listed below and study their multiplication/division facts for homework each night.**

Science

This week, we will continue our study of **Module 4: Forces and Motion**. We will complete lessons 13 and 14 as we answer the phenomenon question: "**What happens when multiple forces act on an object at the same time?**" Students will have a **test** on **Wednesday, April 17th**. This will cover lessons 1-11. They will also have a **quiz** on **Friday, April 19th** covering lessons 13-14 (balanced and unbalanced forces). As a reminder, students should be reading over their learning logs each night as preparation.
