## English Language Arts

This week we will be preparing for our end of year testing. **Our last reading summative test will be Thursday, May 2nd.** We will also continue to prepare for our upcoming LEAP Test beginning on May 6th. Please review homework over the next few weeks with your child, as it will be a direct reflection of what will be seen on the LEAP assessment. Encourage your child to eliminate answers and always go back into the text. Anything done in class can be taken for a grade.

## Social Studies/Flex Group Time

This will be our last week doing Flex Grouping. In social studies, we will continue Unit 2, **Chapter 1: How the United States Government Works.** They will learn about governmental checks and balances and federalism.

## Math

This week in math, we will continue Module 6: Geometry, Measurement, and Data. We will complete lessons 20-23, focusing on collecting and displaying data on graphs. Students will take a Module 6 Topic C (lessons 13-18) quiz on **Friday. Students should complete the page numbers listed below and study their multiplication/division facts for homework each night.**

## Science

This week, we will continue our study of **Module 4: Forces and Motion.** We will complete lessons 15-19 as we answer the phenomenon questions: "What causes a moving object to slow down and stop?" and "What causes an object to stay at rest even when a force is exerted on it?" Students will complete a quiz on L15-18 (*Friction*) on **Wednesday, April 24th.** Additionally, our last **summative test will be on Thursday, May 2nd.** Also, please note that anything done in class can be taken for a grade. As a reminder, students should be reading over their learning logs each night as preparation.
