English Language Arts

This week in ELA, we will begin Unit 1 on Cajun folktales. In this unit, students will read literary and informational text to learn how storytelling can be entertaining as well as educational and develop an understanding of Louisiana's history and culture. **On Friday, students will have a cold-read quiz for a formative grade.** This means the students will be given a folktale to read that they have not read before and required to answer questions about the story to show that they have mastered the skills that have been taught in class. To best prepare for this quiz, the students should complete **the homework due Friday.**

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

This week, during our Flex Group Time, we will begin learning about the various syllable types and how to go through the steps of syllabication. Students are not yet assigned to skill-specific groups. However, teaching syllable types provides students with knowledge of patterns in words. These patterns help them to know how words are pronounced when they are reading and writing. This is essential when students are reading longer, multisyllabic words.

Math

This week in math, we will continue Module 1: Multiplication and Division with Units of 2-5 and 10. We will cover lessons 7-9 which focus on division. We will draw equal groups and arrays to solve both division equations and word problems. Students will take a **Module 1 Topic B quiz (Lessons 6-9) on Wednesday.** Students should complete the Review Guide each night to help prepare for their first summative grade which will be on **Friday, August 25th.**

Science

This week, students will continue to study Weather and Climate and the 1900 Galveston hurricane as we attempt to answer the phenomenon question "What is the weather like where we live?" We will cover lessons 4-7. Students will take a **Module 1, Lessons 4 - 6 quiz on Thursday.** Students should review their logbook and their Learning Log **nightly.**
