English Language Arts

This week we will continue reading our novel *Because of Winn-Dixie*. This week we will discuss how Opal and Winn-Dixie are similar. We will also discuss how Winn-Dixie is helping Opal make friends. By the time we complete this book, we will be able to answer our Culminating Task question, which will be taken as a summative grade: How do the relationships Opal builds develop a theme or central message of the story?

Thursday we will take a summative test over previous books we have read in this unit, it also includes a cold read story. **Homework is due Thursday due to our summative test that day.** The homework is a reflection of what will be on the summative test. In order to be prepared please complete and review the homework.

On **Wednesday**, there will be a **summative (test)** as we conclude **Module 2**. Also, any assignments completed in class will be graded.
