English Language Arts

This week we will continue reading our novel *Because of Winn-Dixie*. This week we will discuss how Opal and Winn-Dixie are similar. We will also discuss how Winn-Dixie is helping Opal make friends. By the time we complete this book, we will be able to answer our Culminating Task question, which will be taken as a summative grade: How do the relationships Opal builds develop a theme or central message of the story? Anything done in class this week can be taken for a grade. Homework this week will be the same story as last week with additional questions. Fluency is due Friday.

Our Flex Groups routine is working smoothly, and our students are putting in tremendous effort in their respective small groups to improve their reading, writing, and overall literacy skills. Math

This week in math, we will continue Module 3: Multiplication and Division with Units of 0, 1, 6, 7, 8, and 9. We will complete lessons 18-21, which focus on word problems and multiplying by multiples of 10. Students should complete the page numbers listed below for homework each night. Students will take a **Topic C Quiz (lessons 13-19) on Thursday**.

Science

This week in **Module 2: Survival**, we will focus on the question, "What happens to organisms when the environment changes?" We will be covering lessons 20-22, where we'll explore the impact of long-term changes in the environment on living organisms. On **Friday**, there will be a **vocabulary quiz** for the students. Also, any assessments taken in class will be graded. To prepare for all upcoming assessments, students are advised to review the Learning Log every night as part of their homework routine.
