English Language Arts

As we move into this week, we will continue "The Louisiana Purchase." We will continue to explore the history of our state of Louisiana and the people involved. Our studies will help us to answer our Culminating Task question at the end of this unit: Who benefited the most and who benefited the least from the Louisiana Purchase and why? This week we will explore the reason France lost its important colony of St. Domingue and how it affected France's control over the Louisiana Territory, ultimately changing the mind of Napoleon to sell the Louisiana Territory. Homework spiral and fluency are due Thursday this week to help us review for our formative on Friday. Please be sure to complete homework with your child, as it prepares your child for the upcoming formative assessment.

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Flex Grouping will continue this week. Each child is placed in their flex group based on their individual needs. This week in social studies, we will be diving into chapter 2: **The Constitutional Convention**. This chapter will teach them the challenges involved in creating the Constitution.

Math

This week in math, we will continue Module 5: Fractions as Numbers. We will complete lessons 7-11, which focus on unit fractions and their relationship to a whole and fractions on a number line. Students will take a **Topic B quiz on Friday**, which will cover lessons 6-10. **Students should complete the page numbers listed below and study their multiplication/division facts for homework each night.**

Science

This week, as part of our academic curriculum, we will be continuing with **Module 3: Traits**. Our focus will be on completing lessons 17, 18, 21, and 22. We will be analyzing and using evidence to explain how traits can be inherited from parents. Furthermore, we will also explore how a plant's inherited traits can be influenced by its environment. To assess our learning progress, there will be an **Inherited Traits quiz (lessons 16-18)** on **Wednesday**. Students are advised to review the Learning Log every night to prepare for all upcoming assessments as part of their daily homework routine.
