**English Language Arts**

As we move into this week, we will continue "The Louisiana Purchase." We will continue to explore the history of our state of Louisiana and the people involved. Our studies will help us to answer our Culminating Task question at the end of this unit: Who benefited the most and who benefited the least from the Louisiana Purchase and why? This week's focus will be on Sacagawea. Homework spiral is due **Friday** this week. Anything done in class can be taken for a grade.

**Social Studies/Flex Group Time**

This week in social studies, we will continue to focus on chapter 2: **The Constitutional Convention**. This chapter will teach them the challenges involved in creating the Constitution. **Friday there will be a quiz on Chapter 2.**

**Math**

This week in math, we will continue Module 5: Fractions as Numbers. We will complete lessons 18 and 19 which focus on comparing fractions with like and unlike units using a number line. Students will take a **Module 5 Summative on Tuesday**, which will cover lessons 1-16. Students should study their completed Review Guide Monday night to prepare for their Summative. **Students should also complete the page numbers listed below and study their multiplication/division facts for homework each night.**

**Science**

This week, we will be focusing on **Module 3: Traits** We will be reviewing for our test Monday. Students will demonstrate their knowledge of traits on their final summative test for the 3rd quarter on Tuesday. Students are encouraged to review the Learning Log every night to prepare for all upcoming assessments. We will also be taking the Science Leap Practice Test on Wednesday so students can learn how to use the testing tools as well as adjust to time limits.
