English Language Arts

As we continue to learn about the Louisiana Purchase and who benefited the most or least, this week we will continue to learn about both York and Sacagawea, two very important figures in the Louisiana Purchase. We will also read poetry to help us better understand how and why poems are created, in addition to learning about the lives that people led during this time. We will focus on the words "stanza" and "verse" to help us understand the different parts of a poem and how poems are organized with rhythm. Homework spiral is due **Friday** this week and will focus on poetry. Anything done in class can be taken for a grade.

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Flex Grouping will continue this week. Each child is placed in their flex group based on their individual needs. This week in social studies, we will start Chapter 3: The First President. They will discover why George Washington was chosen to be the first president of the United States.

Math

This week in math, we will continue Module 5: Fractions as Numbers. We will complete lessons 20 and 22-24, which focus on comparing fractions and equivalent fractions. Students will take a **Module 5 Topic D quiz on Wednesday**, covering lessons 17-20. **Students should complete the page numbers listed below and study their multiplication/division facts for homework each night.**

This week, we will be starting **Module 4: Forces and Motion**. Throughout this module, they will study motion in space. We will complete lessons 1-4 this week as we focus on the question: How can we describe and predict an object's motion? We will explore motion through different activities and create a driving question board.
