English Language Arts

As we move into this week, we will continue "The Louisiana Purchase." We will continue to explore the history of our state of Louisiana and the people involved. Our studies will help us to answer our Culminating Task question at the end of this unit: Who benefited the most and who benefited the least from the Louisiana Purchase and why? This week, we will learn about the United States taking over the Louisiana Territory. Homework spiral and fluency are due Thursday this week. Students will have their last summative test of the quarter on Friday, March 8th. Anything done in class can be taken for a grade.

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Flex Grouping will continue this week. Each child is placed in their flex group based on their individual needs. This week in social studies, we will continue to focus on chapter 2: **The Constitutional Convention**. This chapter will teach them the challenges involved in creating the Constitution.

Math

This week in math, we will continue Module 5: Fractions as Numbers. We will complete lessons 12-16, which focus on fractions on a number line. Students will take a **Topic C quiz on Friday**, which will cover lessons 11-16. **Students should complete the page numbers listed below and study their multiplication/division facts for homework each night.**

Science

This week, we will be focusing on **Module 3: Traits** and will be covering lessons 22, 23, and 25. The main question we will be exploring is: **How do individuals' traits affect their lives?** We will be analyzing and using evidence to explain how certain traits can provide an advantage in finding a mate, and how different traits provide advantages for survival, mating, and reproduction. There will be a **Traits quiz on Tuesday** and a **Vocabulary quiz on Friday**. Students are encouraged to review the Learning Log every night to prepare for all upcoming assessments, including the final summative of the quarter on Tuesday, March 12th, as part of their homework routine.
