English Language Arts

This week we will continue our unit based on the novel *Beauce of Winn-Dixie*. As we continue this unit, we will begin the story *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane*. We will look into the different relationships that Edward builds throughout his journey. In this book, we will also analyze how complex characters develop and interact in the text. Anything done in class this week can be taken for a grade. There is homework and a fluency passage that is due on Friday.

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Our Flex Groups routine is working smoothly, and our students are putting in great effort in their respective small groups to improve their reading, writing, and overall literacy skills. Math

This week in math, we will begin Module 3: Multiplication and Division with Units of 0, 1, 6, 7, 8, and 9 . We will complete lessons 12 and 13, which cover solving one-step word problems involving multiplication and division and counting by units of 9 to multiply. Students will have a **Topic B Quiz (lessons 7-9 and 11-12) on Wednesday**. Students also have a Summative Test on **Friday** which covers Module 3 Lessons 1-12. Students should complete and study their Review Guide to prepare for their Summative.

Science

This week in **Module 2: Survival**, we'll be exploring the important question "How do organisms get what they need to survive?" We will delve into lessons 13-15, where we will learn about the patterns in behavior that reveal living in groups helps animals to survive. To prepare for upcoming assessments, students are advised to review the Learning Log every night.
