English Language Arts

This week we will begin our reading of the novel *Because of Winn-Dixie*. By the time we complete this book, we will be able to answer our Culminating Task question, which will be taken as a summative grade: How do the relationships Opal builds develop a theme or central message of the story? Students will be well prepared to answer this question and provide details of who Opal has learned the central message from throughout our lessons. For this week, please be sure your child is focusing on character traits and how unlikely friendships are made. Anything done in class this week can be taken for a grade. **Please be sure your child completes the homework and fluency this week in preparation for the cold read formative on Friday.**

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Our Flex Groups routine is working smoothly, and our students are putting in great effort in their respective small groups to improve their reading, writing, and overall literacy skills. Math

Science
