English Language Arts

This week we will continue our unit based on the novel *Because of Winn-Dixie*. As we continue this unit, we will begin the story *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane*. We will look into the different relationships that Edward builds throughout his journey. In this book, we will also analyze how complex characters develop and interact in the text. Anything done in class this week can be taken for a grade. There is homework and a fluency passage that is due on Friday.

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Our Flex Groups routine is working smoothly, and our students are putting in great effort in their respective small groups to improve their reading, writing, and overall literacy skills. Math

This week in math, we will begin Module 3: Multiplication and Division with Units of 0, 1, 6, 7, 8, and 9. We will complete lessons 6-9 & 11, which cover multiplication and division concepts with emphasis on units of 6, 7 and 8. Students will have a **Topic A Quiz (lessons 2-6) on Tuesday**. Students should complete the page numbers listed below for homework each night.

Science

This week in **Module 2: Survival**, we'll be exploring the important question "How do organisms get what they need to survive?" We will delve into lessons 10-12, where we will learn about the characteristics of different organisms, analyze their suitability to specific environments, and evaluate their ability to survive. On **Thursday**, students will have a **formative assessment on lessons 9-12**, followed by their first **summative** of the quarter on **Friday**, which will cover **lessons 1-12**. To prepare for these assessments, students are advised to review the Learning Log every night.
