English Language Arts

This week we will begin our Because of Winn-Dixie unit. In this unit, the students will discuss why it is important to have friends who are different from us. We will express our understanding by reading fiction and nonfiction books about unlikely friendships, such as *Charlotte's Web*, *Owen and MZee*, and *Unlikely Friendships for Kids: The Dog & The Piglet: And Four Other Stories of Animal Friendships*. **We will also have a Cold Read Quiz Thursday and finish it Friday.** The Homework this week will help students prepare for the cold read quiz. The Homework is **due Wednesday**.

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Our Flex Groups routine is working smoothly, and our students are putting in great effort in their respective small groups to improve their reading, writing and overall literacy skills. It would be great if you could motivate your child to read every night and ask them about what they are learning during FLEX Grouping. Remember that each child is grouped based on their individual needs.

Math

This week in math, we will wrap up Module 2: Place Value Concepts Through Metric Measurement. On Monday and Tuesday, we will review addition, subtraction, and rounding to help prepare for our End of Module Summative Test which will be on **Wednesday, October 25th**. Since our Summative falls on a Wednesday, the Review Guide will be completed in class. The students will use their completed Review Guide to help them prepare.

Science

This week, we will continue **Module 2: Survival** by answering the important question - "What can fossils reveal about the past?" We will be covering lessons 6-8 as we compare the past environment of an area to the present day to explain how the environment has changed over time. Students are encouraged to review the Learning Log every night.
