## English Language Arts

This week we will continue our unit based on the novel *Because of Winn-Dixie*. As we continue this unit, we will compare and contrast the relationships of Wilbur and Fern in *Charlotte's Web* to Owen and Mzee from *Owen and Mzee: A True Story of Remarkable Friendship*. Furthermore, we will read *Unlikely Friendships for Kids: The Dog and the Piglet*. We will take what we learn from these stories to create posters that demonstrate unlikely friendships. This will help us to make our connection to the Culminating Task at the end of our unit. **There is no fluency passage or homework this week.**

## Social Studies/Flex Group Time

Our Flex Groups routine is working smoothly, and our students are putting in great effort in their respective small groups to improve their reading, writing and overall literacy skills. It would be great if you could motivate your child to read every night and ask them about what they are learning during FLEX Grouping. Remember that each child is grouped based on their individual needs.

## Math

This week in math, we will begin Module 3: Multiplication and Division with Units of 0, 1, 6, 7, 8, and 9. We will complete lessons 2, 3, and 5, which cover multiplication and division concepts with emphasis on units of 6 and 8. **Students should complete the page numbers listed below for homework each night.**

## Science

This week, we will continue **Module 2: Survival** by answering the important question - "How do organisms get what they need to survive?" We will be covering lessons 9 and 10 as we observe organisms, identify the organisms' needs for survival, and develop models. There will be a summative on Friday, November 10th. This will cover lessons 1-12. Students are encouraged to review the Learning Log every night.
