### English Language Arts

Our year is flying by, as we are already concluding our first unit of the year in ELA this week. As our week progresses, we will work together to answer our Culminating Task question, "Why is the rabbit a good animal to play a trickster?" Students will use the information from their notes and discussions that we have learned throughout the unit to help answer this question. In addition, students will answer questions at the beginning of the week based on the stories that we have read. Students will then be given feedback on the questions to help them best compose their culminating task writing, which will be finalized on Friday. Throughout this work, students will receive their first summative grade of the second quarter, which will include the questions answered at the beginning of the week, in addition to the culminating task that is completed at the end of the week. There will be no homework this week, except for the Fluency Folder. The passage this week is from a story we have read in class, *Tops and Bottoms*.

### Social Studies/Flex Group Time

We have been meeting with our Flex Groups for a few weeks now. Students are working with small groups on targeted skills to help improve their reading and writing skills or overall literacy skills. Ask your child about what he/she is learning during FLEX Grouping. Remember, each child is grouped according to his/her individual needs.

### Math

This week in math, we will continue Module 2: Place Value Concepts Through Metric Measurement. We will learn lessons 17-22, which focus on addition and subtraction with two-digit and three-digit numbers. Students should complete the page numbers listed below for homework each night. **Although we are learning various addition and subtraction strategies, students are able to select any strategy to help them solve each problem.**

### Science

This week, we will continue **Module 2: Survival** as we answer the question, "How do butterflies survive over time in a changing environment?" We will complete lessons 2-4. We will have a formative (quiz) on **Thursday, October 12th**. This assessment will cover lessons 1-3 (Organism/environment). Please have your child review his/her Log Book and Learning Log nightly.
