English Language Arts

As we continue our Cajun Folktales unit, we will continue to learn more about character traits and characteristics of characters using the character's thoughts and actions. We will learn how crops grow differently to understand how the rabbit characters uses that knowledge to trick other characters. We do not have any quizzes or tests this week, but there is a homework packet. Please continue to complete homework each week to help your child prepare for future assessments and reinforce the skills learned in class. *Class assignments may be taken as a formative grade this week.*

Social Studies/Flex Group Time

This week, during our Flex Group Time, we will begin moving into various literacy groups. Students have now been assigned to teachers based on specific skills needed. Each teacher will provide reading and writing (literacy) instruction based on the individual group's needs.

Math

This week in math, we will wrap up Module 1: Multiplication and Division with Units of 2-5 and 10. We will cover lessons 22-23, which focus on solving two-step word problems using properties of multiplication, drawings, and equations. Students will take a **multiplication quiz on 2s, 5s, & 10s on Wednesday** and a **Summative Test on Friday, September 15th**. Students should complete their Review Guide each night to help prepare for the Summative.

Science

This week, students will continue to study Weather and Climate and the 1900 Galveston hurricane as we discuss climate and climate zones. The students will take a **Climate vs Weather (lesson 12) quiz on Thursday** where they will decide if scenarios describe climate or weather. We will finish the week by introducing the Engineering Challenge (experiment) for this module.
