

Dear Parents and Guardians of Team 5 Students,

Your student should be completing work daily in each class while he or she is at home. It is important that students do their best to keep up with the work while they are out to avoid being behind when they return.

Where to Find Work

Assignments for each class can be found on Google Classroom. Student log-in information for Google Classroom can be found on a sticker placed on the inside cover of their student planner. If students have questions, they can message teachers through Google Classroom directly, or you can reach out via email or School Status text. Below are specific instructions for accessing work in each of your student's core classes.

Students are encouraged to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time for each subject using the link in Google Classroom. This is encouraged but not required. See the regular school day schedule to the right for class times.

Instructions for Each Class

ELA (Cart) - Students are welcome to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class times in order to participate in the day's lesson. This is not mandatory, however it is highly encouraged! If the student chooses not to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day. Please reach out to Ms. Cart (mcart@stcharles.k12.la.us) if you have any questions.

ELA (Majeste) - Students should log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class times in order to participate in the day's lesson. The Google Meet link is a recurring link that will be located at the top of their Google Classroom for my class. This is not mandatory, however it is highly encouraged! If the student chooses not to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day. Please reach out to Ms. Majeste (kmajeste@stcharles.k12.la.us) if you have any questions.

Math (Houston) - Students should log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class times in order to participate in the day's lesson. The Google Meet link is a recurring link that will be located at the top of their Google Classroom for my class. This is not mandatory, however it is highly encouraged! If the student chooses not to join the Google Meet, they should notify Mrs. Houston via an email or comment in Google Classroom so they can receive instructions for the day. Each day's completed lesson notes will be posted on the stream of their Google Classroom. There, they can see how each problem is worked step by step. If you or your child have any questions, please email Mrs. Houston at ahouston@stcharles.k12.la.us.

Math (LeVeck) - Students have the opportunity to learn virtually each day they are out. Students should log in to a live Google Meet in order to participate in the day's lesson. The Google Meet link is a recurring link that is located at the top of our Google Classroom. The Google Meet will begin at roughly 2:10pm on A-Days and 1:10pm on B-days. Students should strive to complete all assignments done during the Google Meet session, posted in Google Classroom, as well as homework found on the Weekly Agenda. This is not mandatory, however it is highly encouraged! If you or your child have any questions, please email Mrs. LeVeck at mmelanconleveck@stcharles.k12.la.us.

Gifted Math (Goodman)-Students are encouraged to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time in order to participate in the day's lesson. Assignments and notes can be found in their Google Classroom for the week. If notes are given in class that day they will also be linked in the students Google-Slide for that day. Video links can also be found at the end of each day's lesson to support what students are doing in class. Please reach out to Mrs. Goodman (sgoodman@stcharles.k12.la.us) if you have any questions.

Science (Guillot)- Students are welcome to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time in order to participate in the day's lesson. This is not mandatory, however it may be beneficial. If the student chooses not to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day. Social Studies (Zeringue) -Students should log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class times in order to participate in the day's lesson/get directions. The Google Meet link will be located at the top of their Google Classroom for my class. This is not mandatory, however it is highly encouraged! If the student chooses not to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day.
