

Dear Parents and Guardians,

While your student is at home for the next few days, we know learning may become a challenge, but we want to reassure you that we are here to support you and your child every step of the way. Your student should be completing work daily in each class while he or she is at home. It is important that students do their best to keep up with the work while they are out to avoid being behind when they return.

Where to Find Work

Assignments for each class can be found on Google Classroom. Student log-in information for Google Classroom can be found on a sticker placed on the inside cover of their student planner. If students have questions, they can message teachers through Google Classroom directly, or you can reach out via email or School Status text. Below are specific instructions for accessing work in each of your student's core classes.

Students are encouraged to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time for each subject using the link in Google Classroom. This is encouraged but not required.

ELA - Students are welcome to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time in order to participate in the day's lesson. This is not mandatory, however it may be beneficial. If the student chooses not to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day. Please reach out to Mrs. Trotter or Mrs. Maxie if you have any questions.

Math - Students are welcome to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time in order to participate in the day's lesson. On the agenda there will be a **YES** next to Google Meet if students should login for live lessons that day. Students do not need to login for assessment days or digital lesson days, there will be a **NO** next to Google Meets. Check Google Classroom daily and complete the assigned work. There are videos posted that will walk students through the math concepts for that day. Slides are also posted for each lesson. Please reach out to Mrs. Aymond if you have any questions about an assignment.

Science - Students are welcome to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time in order to participate in the day's lesson. This is not mandatory, however it may be beneficial. If the student chooses not to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day. Please reach out to Mrs. Dufrene if you have any questions.

Social Studies - Students are welcome to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time in order to participate in the day's lesson. This is not mandatory, however it may be beneficial. Check Google Classroom daily and complete the assigned work. Please reach out to Ms. Ocmand if you have any questions about an assignment.

If you foresee there being problems with your internet, please contact the school directly to make arrangements to pick up student work at the office. Again we are here to support you both during your student's time away from the classroom. Please don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions or concerns.
