Math: This week the students will learn about the following topics:

- Division of tens and ones by one-digit numbers (L13-16)
- **Module 2, Lesson 11-14 quiz** on Wednesday, October 11th

As a reminder, students should be studying their multiplication facts nightly. In addition, students can use their Apply book for extra practice on the skills we are covering in class.

Social Studies: This week we will cover the following:

- Begin Unit 1 - Prehistory and the Agricultural Revolution
- Learn about Early Humans and the Paleolithic World
- Describe early migration out of Africa
- Understand hunter-gatherer societies, including their use of hunting weapons, fire, shelter, and tools

Students should utilize the Student Reader, activity pages, note sheet, and vocabulary sheet to review the material learned in class nightly. The Student Reader will go home each afternoon and should be returned the following day. Students are responsible for any damages caused to their copy.

ELA: As we approach the end of the Whipping Boy unit, we will utilize the novel and other mentor texts to:

- Utilize testing strategies to prepare for our second comprehension test on **Tuesday**
- Complete Single Paragraph Outlines (SPOs) to prepare for the Enhanced Culminating Task (ECT). Please note that this summative will have two portions:
 - 1st part: Culminating writing task
 - 2nd part: Comprehension portion **next Friday**. This ECT will be scored together and count as the first summative grade of the second quarter.

Weekly fluency homework can be found in the students' purple folders. Completed folders must be returned on Friday.

Science: This week we will cover the following:

- Apply the engineering design process to design a structure to reduce damage related to a landslide(erosion). (Lessons 12-17)
