Reminders:

Math: This week the students will learn about the following topics:

- Multiplying two-digit, three-digit, and four-digit numbers by one-digit numbers using various methods (L12)
- Multiplying two-digit numbers by two-digit numbers using various methods (L13-17)
- Students will take a quiz on **Friday, December 8th** that will cover Lessons 9-12.

ELA: We will continue with the Guidebooks unit, *The Lightning Thief*, by Rick Riordan to explore the central question: How do myths and other stories help us make sense of the world? Students will:

- Continue reading *The Lightning Thief*
- Analyze characters and mythical elements of a text
- Refer to details in the text to make inferences
- Comprehension quiz on **Wednesday, December 6th**
- Comprehension test on **Friday, December 8th**.

Weekly Fluency homework can be found in the student's purple folders. Completed folders are due Friday.

Social Studies: This week we will cover the following:

- Analyze and assess the significance of the Code of Hammurabi
- Describe the achievements of Mesopotamian civilizations
- Discover how geography affected trade between ancient city-states

Science: This week we will cover the following:

- Model how windmills transfer and transform energy and explain that energy makes things happen when it is transferred and transformed. (L 15-16)
- Students will take a quiz on **Module 2, Lessons 13-15** this Thursday, December 7th.
