Math: This week the students will learn about the following topics:

Science: This week we will cover the following:

- Learn how human-made structures such as dams can change nearby natural features and processes (L 21-22).
- Investigate how the environment is impacted by human use of energy resources (L23-24).
- **Module 1, Lessons 18-20 Quiz** on Tuesday, September 26th.

ELA: As we continue with our Whipping Boy unit, we will utilize the novel and other mentor texts to learn the following:

- Utilize text evidence to explain how details and dialogue in the text help to add to our understanding of characters and their motivations
- Analyze characters' dialogue and actions to gain an understanding of how and why the characters and their relationships are changing
- Complete Single Paragraph Outlines (SPOs) by providing a topic sentence, supporting details, and a conclusion sentence

*On **Friday**, there will be a quiz on The Writing Revolution (TWR) skills, including expanding kernel sentences, subordinating conjunctions, and completing an SPO. Students will be responsible for writing complete sentences, using correct capitalization and punctuation. There is a TWR section in your child's binder.

Weekly fluency homework can be found in the students purple folders. Students should read at least 3 nights this week and record their progress. Folders with completed questions and charts must be returned to school this Friday. For extra writing practice, students have received a September calendar with various prompts.
