COPYRIGHT AND USE OF VIDEOS/DVDs COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

I have received and read the district policy and regulations concerning **COPYRIGHT COMPLIANCE**.

- I have attended a training session on the district policy and regulations and on the copyright law, Title 17, United States Code, Public Law 94-553, 90 Stat 2541, as amended.
- I understand the district policy and regulations. Any use of instructional materials and audiovisual equipment will be in accordance with both federal law and district policy and regulations.
- All materials used, such as videotapes, DVDs, computer software, transparencies, etc. shall be part of the teaching activities stated in my lesson plans. I shall be able to point to specific outcomes and shall be prepared to justify how these materials assist attaining these outcomes.

I have read and received a copy of the guidelines for the **selection and use of videos/DVDs**.

- The use of any video/DVD purchased with personal funds or rented from a video store or club is prohibited.
- ONLY films of G, PG, or PG-13 rating may be purchased and shown. NO film having a MPAA rating of R, NC-17, or X may be shown under any circumstances (4.07 REPRODUCTION OF COPYRIGHTED MATERIAL)
- Video/DVDs and/or clips should only be shown in their entirety if the length is 20 minutes or less.
- All showings are to include an introduction/purpose for viewing and follow-up activities after viewing the segment.
- All video segments shown shall be listed on lesson plans.
