

DESTREHAN HIGH SCHOOL Fighting Wildcats LETTERMEN JACKET REQUIREMENTS

The Base Price of a Lettermen Jacket is \$80. Destrehan High School (through each individual sport/club) will pay \$40 toward the price of the student's jacket. The student will be responsible for the remaining \$40 plus any options ordered.

** If a student receives a jacket, then quits a sport/club before the season is over, then the student will be held responsible for the \$40 that the DHS Sport/Club paid toward the jacket.

DHS will add the fee to the student's FEE LIST.

DHS Lettermen Jackets will be ordered in the Spring of each year.

ATHLETICS:

Junior:

*A Student will be at least a 1 year Letterman prior to their Senior season.

Sophomore:

- *A student will be at least a 1 year Letterman
- *Also have an overall 3.25 GPA through the Fall of their Sophomore year.

ROTC:

A cadet must actively participate on one of the four competition teams for three years with one of those three years being the student's Senior year.

STUDENT COUNCIL

Senior member who have lettered at least 3 years (been involved in the club for at least 2 years plus their senior year) will be eligible to receive a senior jacket

CHOIR:

In order to receive a choir jacket – The student must participate in Choir every semester in some capacity (class or after school practices or the musical) for three years (9 - 11) and then also be a member of the choir in their Senior year.

BAND:

Senior Jackets:

A student must participate in both semesters (Fall/Spring) for 4 years to qualify for a jacket.

If the student is not in the class in the Fall then the student is covered by being in the marching band.

Specifics relative to Wind players

A student must be enrolled in the spring semester in the Symphonic Band if they are a wind player. If a student has a verifiable academic/TOPS conflict they must attend any and all after school rehearsals and perform with the symphonic band. A minimum of 5 band classes must be taken during the four years with academic conflicts filling any missing semesters. In the Spring if a student is not in the class then the student must attend after school rehearsals and perform at District and State with the Concert or Symphonic Band.

Specifics relative to Percussion and Guard

The student must be in the Fall Marching class and marching band all four years. Percussionists must either be in the Music elective class, Indoor Drumline, or Symphonic Band in the Spring. A minimum of 5 band classes must be taken during the four years with academic conflicts filling any missing semesters.

The student must participate with the Winterguard or Indoor Percussion and perform in LMCGPC events.

If a student quits or is dismissed, then the student forfeits the right to a senior jacket.

Overall Information

When a junior is deemed eligible, he or she must be present on the day of jacket sizing; no alternative date will be available. If you miss the sizing date, you may not be eligible to receive your jacket.

Participation in band is an ALL YEAR activity. We Are Always "In Season".

- -Participation in Football Band(half-time show), Winter/Spring Concert, Symphonic Band, Concert, Winter Guard, or Indoor Percussion
- -Participation in the Symphonic Band, Concert, Winterguard or Indoor Percussion
- -Participation in all Mardi Gras Parades and the Norco parade

Participation in all of the above listed activities is necessary in order for a student to receive a jacket.

The Band Director reserves the right to refuse a person their jacket if these obligations are not met.

In addition to these requirements, a student must schedule band as an elective class for the entire senior year. If a conflict arises, the staff must be advised in order to alleviate the problem as soon as possible and to find other arrangements if possible. If the class cannot be scheduled the student must attend all practices and performances. You must participate both semesters to qualify for a jacket all four years.

If a student decides to leave band for a semester and return, they are ineligible to receive a jacket. If a senior does not fulfill their obligation before they are a senior, they are also ineligible to receive a jacket.

If a Senior does not fulfill their obligation from the beginning of their freshman year to the last day of school in their senior year their deposit will not be refunded.
