

## Students Excluded for Close Contact

Dear Parents and Guardians,

While your student is at home for the next few weeks, we know learning may become a challenge, but we want to reassure you that we are here to support you and your child every step of the way. Your student is expected to complete work daily in each class while they are at home. It is important that students do their best to keep up with the work while they are out to avoid being behind when they return to school. Assignments for each class can be found on Google Classroom. Student log-in information for Google Classroom can be found on a sticker placed on the inside cover of their student planner. If students have questions, they can message teachers directly through Google Classroom or you can reach out via email or School Status. Below are specific instructions for accessing work in each of your student's core classes.

**ELA (Clements)** - There will be lessons recorded under "Classroom Resources" in Google Classroom with student-paced Nearpod lessons. Students can choose to work through the Nearpod lesson at their own pace or are welcome to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time (1st Period: 8:25-9:25, A Day: 10:25-11:25 - B Day: 12:05-1:05 and 2nd Period: 9:25-10:25 & 2:05-3:05). This is not mandatory, however it may be beneficial. If the student chooses not to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day. I will be available from 1:05-2:05 on Google Meet to answer any questions about assignments, and will also respond to questions through Google Classroom comments throughout the day. **ELA (Harville)** - Students are expected to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time. (1st: 8:25-9:25, 2nd: 9:25-10:25, 5th: 1:05-2:05, 6th: 2:05-3:05) in order to participate in the day's lesson. If the student is unable to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day. **Math (Whitney)**- Check Google Classroom daily and complete the assigned work. There will be videos posted that go through the same examples that we will cover in class. Each day there will be a form posted for students to fill out to explain what they completed. I will also be available from 8:00-9:00 on Google meet on select days to answer any questions about assignments. **Math (Rome)** - Students are encouraged to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time in order to participate in the day's lesson. While this is not mandatory, students are less likely to fall behind if they participate in the daily live lessons. If the student is unable to join the Google Meet, he/she should check Google Classroom daily. Assignments and notes can be found in the Google Slide file under the Weekly Agenda assignment. If teacher-made worksheets are distributed for extra practice, students can find those under each day's assignment. Please reach out to Mrs. Rome if you have any questions.

**Science** - Students are expected to log in to a live Google Meet during their normal class time in order to participate in the day's lesson. If the student is unable to join the Google Meet, they should complete the work assigned in Google Classroom for that day. Please reach out Mr. Perrin if you have any questions.

**Social Studies** - Students are expected to log onto Google Meet during their normal class time to participate in each day's lesson (1st: 8:25-9:25, 2nd: 9:25-10:25, 4th: 12:05-1:05, & 5th: 1:05-2:05). If the student is unable to join, they must complete the articles for that day. Please reach out to Ms. Morvant [jmorvant@stcharles.k12.la.us](mailto:jmorvant@stcharles.k12.la.us) if you have any questions.

If you foresee there being problems with your internet, please contact the school directly to make arrangements to pick up student work at the office. Again, we are here to support you during your student's time away from the classroom. **If your child exhibits symptoms and is unable to complete work, please contact us so that we can make other arrangements to help in this matter.** Please don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions or concerns.
