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NOTES & REMINDERS:

Math:

 - Module 1 Math Google classroom

- On Tuesday, we will start on Module 1, "Place Value & Decimal Fractions," Topic A: Multiplicative Patterns and Place Value Chart

Science:

- This week we will focus on routines and procedures in our science classroom.

- Students will receive a Science Safety Contract this week. This should be reviewed at home, signed, and returned to school by Tuesday, August 18th.
