NOTES & REMINDERS:

Math:

- We will be wrapping up Topic A section in Module 1 with introducing exponents (powers of 10) and units of measurement.
- Two formatives will be given this week. (Monday & Thursday)
- We will take our Math Diagnostic Test on Thursday and Friday.
- Remember to use your Conceptual Development notes as a guide and study your multiplication facts.

Science:

- This week we will continue working in Module 1. The students will begin exploring the properties of matter through investigations and a variety of stimuli.
- Students are expected to participate in classroom discussions in order to fully understand the concepts being explored. They will also be taking notes in their science workbooks in order to reference while reviewing and studying at home.
- Students received a notes sheet for Module 1 today. This notes sheet needs to be brought to school each day in order to be properly completed and filled out.
- The Science Safety Contract is due back to school tomorrow, August 18, 2020.
- Students will take a safety quiz on Thursday, August 20th.
- A formative assessment is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, August 26th. It will cover Lessons 1-5 in Module 1.

Social Studies:

- We will begin studying Indigenous Cultures this week.
- Students will analyze the characteristics that make a civilization. We will also be introduced to the Aztecs and study some ancient Aztec objects.
- A graphic organizer for characteristics of civilization will be completed throughout the week. This should be reviewed at home nightly.
- Students can expect a formative assessment that covers these topics next Wednesday, August 26th.

ELA:

- Students will continue reading Part One of Wonderstruck and summarizing the text. They will also practice quoting accurately from the text to support inferences. The students will begin to bring the book home, Please make sure your child brings it back to school every day.
